Kieran Pender on Oliver Bullough's Moneyland



How can you fix 'Moneyland'? The rise of globalisation and the liberalisation of financial policy has had unexpected consquences with potentially dire implications for society. A new global élite that operates largely beyond the reach of domestic regulation has risen with the assistance of seemingly respectable lawyers, bankers, and real estate agents. For this new élite, corruption underpins wealth and money trumps all.
