TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Poets are encouraged to submit their entries online via the ABR website. N.B. If you do enter online, do not complete this entry form or submit hard copies.

- 1. Entries must be one single-authored poem of no more than 100 lines, written in English.
- 2. Previously published or prize-winning works will not be accepted. Entries should not be on offer to other publications or prizes or anthologies for the duration of the Prize.
- 3. Entrants may be Australian or international; all poets worldwide are entitled to enter.
- 4. Multiple entries are permitted. Separate entry forms are required for each entry. Multiple entries may be paid for with one cheque or credit card transaction.
- 5. Entry forms can be obtained from the ABR website or by sending a stamped and self-addressed envelope to ABR.
- 6. Poems must be printed on single-sided A4 paper. Only one copy is needed. Manuscripts will not be returned.
- 7. The entrant's name must NOT be written on the manuscript itself only on the entry form.
- 8. Each entry must be accompanied by an entry fee of \$22, or \$15 for current ABR subscribers. To qualify for the discount fee, entrants must hold a current one-year subscription to our print or online edition.
- 9. Cheques should be made payable to Australian Book Review, or credit card details can be supplied overleaf.
- 10. The closing date for entries is 20 November 2013. Entries postmarked 20 November are acceptable. Late entries will not be considered. Entrants on email will be notified by email re receipt of entries but entrants should note this may take up to three weeks after the closing date because of the large volume of entries. Do not contact us before then if you have not received confirmation.
- 11. Entries will not be accepted by email or fax. They should be posted to: Australian Book Review, Porter Prize, Studio 2, 207–229 City Road, Southbank Vic. 3006 or submitted via our website.
- 12. ABR staff, board members, and editorial advisers are not eligible to enter. ABR contributors and volunteers may enter.
- 13. If entrants subsequently withdraw their entries, the entry fee will not be refunded.
- 14. The judges' decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 15. A shortlist comprising a maximum of six poems will be announced and those poems will be published in the March 2014 issue of ABR.
- 16. The winner will be announced later in March or April.
- 17. ABR reserves the right not to award a prize.
- 18. The stated prize money also covers publication in ABR Online and in eBook form.
- 19. Entrants must sign the Declaration overleaf to be eligible.
